And lastly, the State of California is battling budget deficits at catastrophic levels, which directly impacts County services.

Unfortunately, the decline in revenue is not a short-term problem for County operations, and long-term solutions are needed. Our strong fiscal discipline has allowed the County to decisively respond to the current financial challenge, and will also allow us to find innovative ways to take action for the future. Tough decisions must be made. We have a responsibility to the taxpayers to explore any and all cost saving measures. One cost saving option is to identify additional services for outsourcing. As I stated in the State of the County address, "we already know that - in some situations - the private and non-profit sectors can perform services cheaper than government without compromising quality."
