MINUTE ORDER NO. 2

SUBJECT: Prohibition Of Consumption Of Alcoholic Beverages In Parts Of Lakeside And Spring Valley (District: 2)

OVERVIEW:

The County's regulatory ordinance for alcoholic beverage consumption prohibition restricts drinking in certain areas of the County. The communities of Julian, Fallbrook, Rainbow, Harbison Canyon, La Cresta, Borrego Springs, La Presa, Casa De Oro, Valley Center, Ramona, Fairbanks Ranch and Bonsall currently have areas that fall under this ordinance.

The intent of the ordinance is to improve public safety and enhance the quality of life in communities that have been plagued by persons drinking alcohol in public areas. Several parts of Lakeside and Spring Valley continue to experience problems with public drinking. Residents are harassed, vandalism and other crimes take place, and community character is diminished.

This proposal will add parts of Lakeside and Spring Valley to the list of areas where alcohol consumption is prohibited in public areas.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact as a result of this request.

RECOMMENDATION:

Adding the following recommendation: "Direct the Chief Administrative Officer to work with County Counsel, the District Attorneys Office and the City Attorneys in cities where the punishment is a misdemeanor, to determine if county ordinance can be strengthened to punish these offenses as a misdemeanor and return to the Board within sixty days if the law

allows there to be a modification;" ON MOTION of Supervisor Slater, seconded by Supervisor Jacob, the Board of Supervisors took action as recommended, on Consent, introducing Ordinance for further consideration on October 29, 2002.
